#### Comments:

The Burdekin recorded another good crushing week with throughput exceeding 400,000 tonnes. Favourable weather is paving the way for good cane quality and bin weights. Total throughput for the year is now over three million tonnes.

Average weekly CCS continues to climb steadily and finished the week at 14.61 units, which is now only just below budget.

The highest CCS sample was 18.0 from a rake of Q183 first ratoon cane in the Invicta area.

There has been an increase in the number of near misses at cane rail crossings recently and some details have been provided to police.

Members of the Burdekin community are urged to remain vigilant around our cane rail crossings we head towards the season's halfway mark. Please use your train brain and always give way to cane trains.
