#### Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 345,000 tonnes for the week.

The reduced throughput was due to an extended cleaning stop at Inkerman to repair a leaking boiler tube and an extended stop at Pioneer to clean the ID fan.

There was a scheduled stop at Invicta Mill to conduct a B-side clean.

This week both Pioneer and Kalamia mills passed the 1 million tonnes crushed milestone.

Average weekly CCS increased by just under half a unit to reach 15.77, which is above budget. Season to date CCS is now up to 14.33 units.

The highest CCS sample was 19.1 from a rake of Q240 second ratoon cane in the Invicta area.
