#### Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 410,000 tonnes for the week.

This was the best weekly throughput for the season to date and came as a result of consistent performance at all four mills.

Cleaning and maintenance days are scheduled for Pioneer and Invicta B side during the coming week.

Average weekly CCS dropped slightly to 15.65, which is still above budget. Season to date CCS is now up to 14.42 units.

The highest CCS sample was 18.90 from a rake of Q240 second ratoon cane in the Invicta area.

The Burdekin mills have now processed more than 70% of the total estimated crop.
