#### Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just under 355,000 tonnes this week.

This was above budget, although throughput was reduced by an unscheduled stop at Inkerman.

The Burdekin region has now crushed just under 7.6 million tonnes of cane, which is 95 per cent of the total estimated crop.

Average weekly CCS fell to 14.9 units, which is still above budget.

The highest CCS sample was 18.30 from a rake of Q208 fifth ratoon cane in the Invicta area.

Invicta Mill crushed out on Sunday morning, making it the first of the Burdekin mills to finish the season. Its total throughput was about 3.12 million tonnes of cane.

Kalamia Mill will finish on Wednesday this week with Pioneer and Inkerman due to complete crushing next week.
